How to use Cochrane Interactive Learning

Menu

The main menu enables you to access all the content pages in this module. The topic titles are displayed on the dark blue strip and each page tile within the topic is displayed below. You can select the page tiles to open the pages.

Each page tile has a star icon on it which can be selected to highlight your favourite pages, i.e. those pages that you might need to return to regularly. You can then use the filter menu, described next, to view your favourite pages.

Some topics will have pages that are not initially shown when you first open the menu. To access these pages you must select, or swipe, the arrows (as highlighted in the image).
