

The Cochrane Library 2012 Impact Factor and usage report

When considering the data presented below, please be aware of the following:

- An error in the 2012 Impact Factor calculation was detected and reported to Thomson ISI. The corrected Impact Factor was published on the 30th September, 2013.
- The dataset we have used to generate impact factors for individual review groups (ISI Web
 of Science) is slightly different to the dataset that ISI use to calculate the impact factors of
 journals (the Journal Citation Report). Individual Cochrane Review Group (CRG) impact
 factor data, therefore, should not be quoted as "official" impact factors, but can be used
 within the Collaboration.
- Both ISI databases (Web of Science and Journal Citation Report) report upon the number of articles published in a year. For The Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews (CDSR) this means all new reviews plus all updated Reviews that have a new citation record.
- Each individual review group faces a variety of challenges in the publication of Cochrane Reviews, and some of these may impact upon the data presented below. For example, if a CRG publishes a large number of updated Reviews with new citation records these may increase the ratio of publications to citations, thereby lowering the impact factor.

1. The impact factor of the *Cochrane Database of Systematic Reviews* (CDSR):

- a) Each year in June, Thomson Reuters publish the impact factors of all journals indexed in the ISI Journal Citation Report.
- b) The 2012 impact factor for CDSR is **5.785**, which describes the ratio of the number of reviews published during 2010 and 2011 (1398) to the number of citations these reviews received in 2012 (8087).
 - A review published in the CDSR in 2010 or 2011 was cited, on average, 5.785 times in 2012.
- c) The top 10 cited reviews (2012) published in the CDSR (all CRGs) contributing to the 2012 impact factor are:

d) CDSR is ranked 12th of 155 journals in the "Medicine, General and Internal" category, placing it in the top five percent of all titles listed in the ISI Journal Citation Report:

e) Although the Impact Factor of the CDSR fell in 2012, for the second consecutive year, the total number of citations received is the 7th highest in the Medicine, General & Internal category.

The 5-Year Impact Factor increased to 6.553. This is calculated by taking the number of cites in 2012 to items published between 2007 and 2011 (20,727) and dividing this by the number of items published between 2007 and 2011 (3,163).

f) A look at the breakdown of the CDSR impact factor by year from 2009-2012 shows that the reviews published in 2010 were not as highly cited in the 2012 and 2011 Impact Factor windows as the equivalent set of reviews published in previous years.

The number of reviews published in the CDSR in 2011 was 1.4% lower than in 2010. The CDSR published the second highest number of citable items of the journals in the Medicine, General & Internal category in 2011. The top 5 journals in terms of number of citable items published in 2011 are:

21% of reviews published in 2011 were not cited in the 2012 impact factor window compared with 18% published in 2010 that were not cited in the 2011 impact factor window.

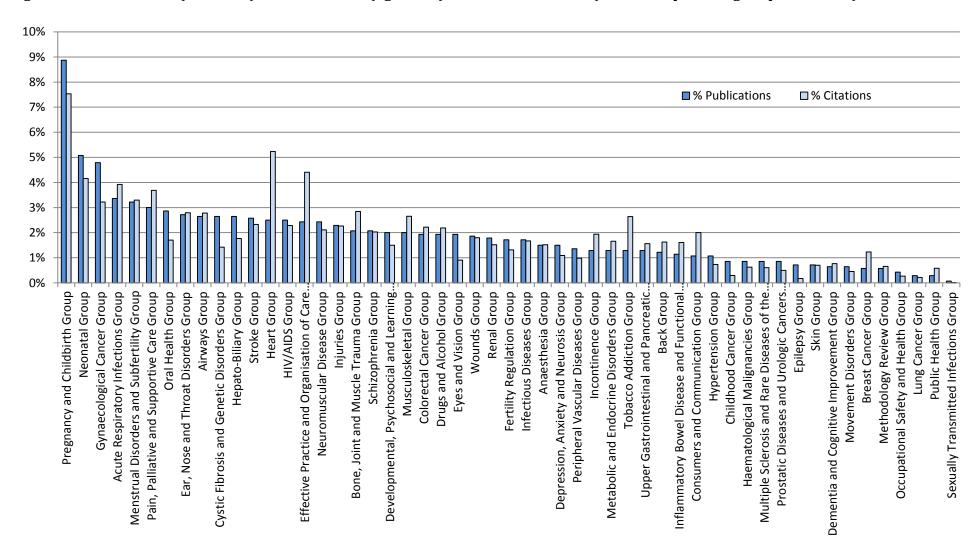
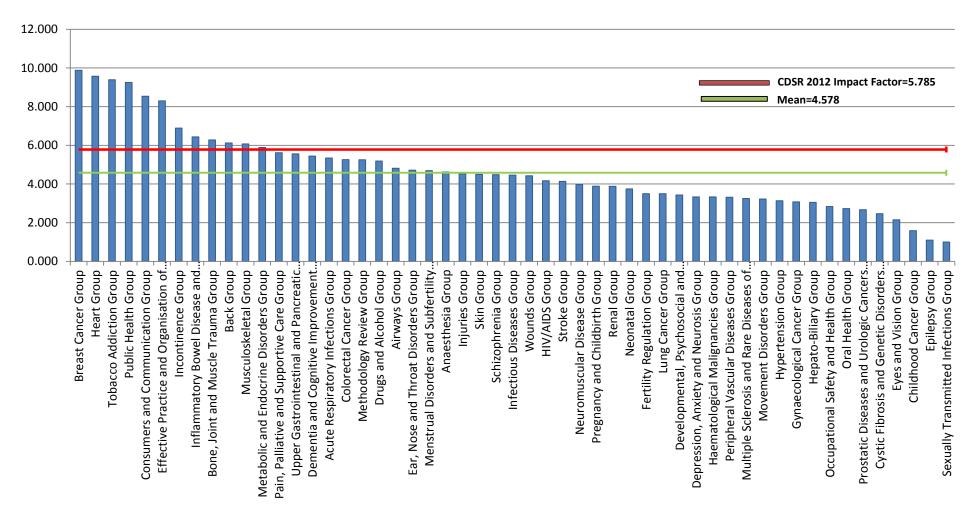






Figure 2: "Impact Factor" for each CRG (i.e. number of cites in 2012 to reviews published in 2010–2011, divided by the number of reviews published in 2010–2011)

2. The impact factors of individual Cochrane Review Groups (CRGs):

a) **Figure 1**, details the number of publications and citations contributing to the 2012 impact factor for each CRG as a percentage of the CDSR. **Figure 2** shows the 2012 CRG impact factor for each CRG. It is important to remember that these figures have been calculated using datasets from ISI Web of Science and are not 'official' impact factors.





Figure 1: % Publications (dark blue) and % Citations (light blue) of CDSR for each CRG (in order of percentage of publications)

3. How the citation data compare to Wiley Online Library usage data:

- a) Each Review in CDSR, regardless of publication date, was accessed in full-text format on average 715.34 times during 2012 (5,586 articles accessed 3,995,874 times). This is an increase of 20.6% on the 2011 figure of 567.89 (5,134 articles accessed 2,915,558 times).

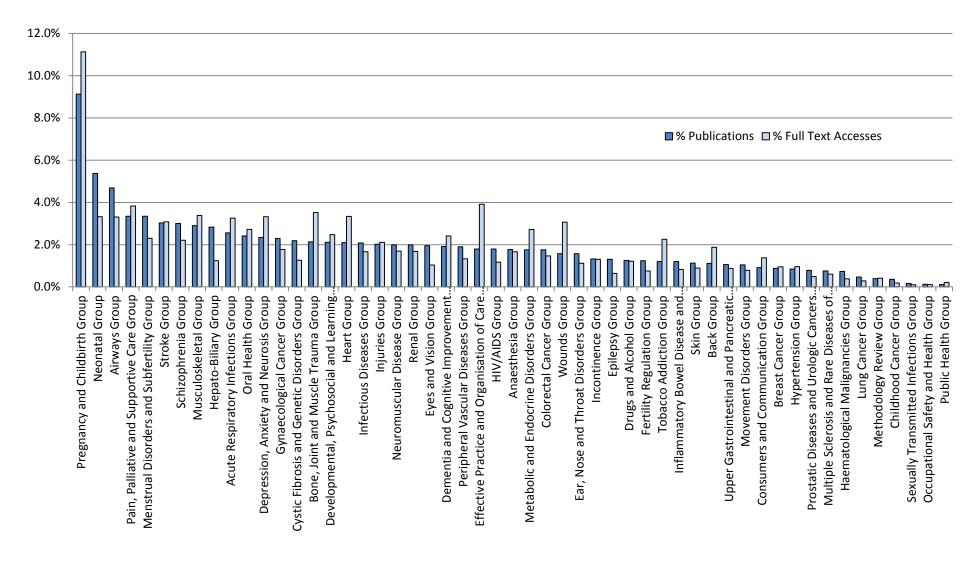
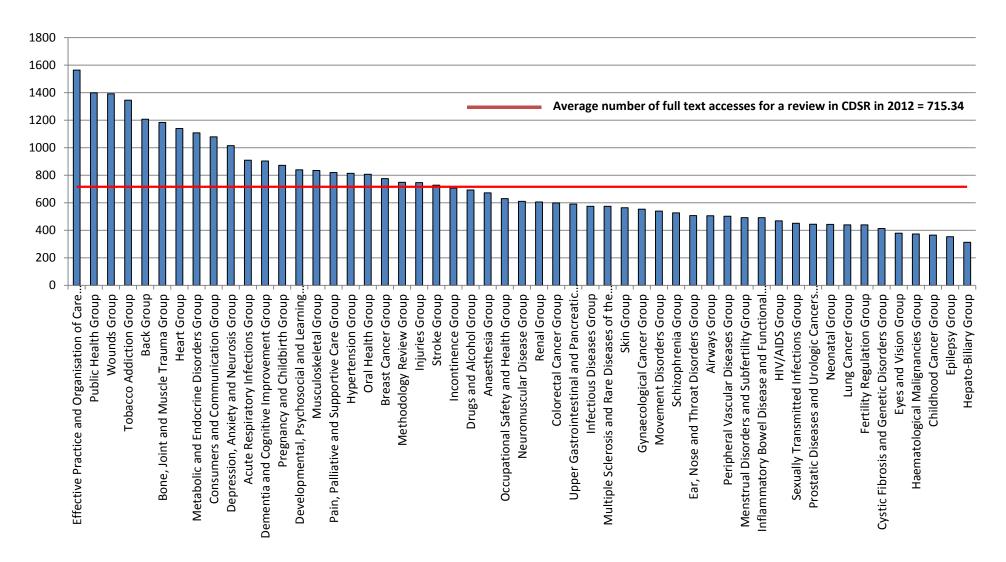






Figure 4: Average number of full-text accesses during 2012 by Cochrane Review Group

4. The usage of individual Cochrane Review Groups:

a) **Figure 3**, details the number of publications and full text accesses contributing to the usage figure of 715.34 for each CRG as a percentage of the CDSR. **Figure 4** shows the average usage per review as accessed via Wiley Online Library during 2012 (regardless of publication date).





Figure 3: % Publications (dark blue) and % Full Text Accesses (light blue) of CDSR for each CRG (in order of percentage of publications)

5. Increasing the reach of Cochrane Reviews

- a) Podcasts are recorded, a Cochrane Journal Club is produced and Cochrane Reviews were press released on a monthly basis in 2012. These three initiatives undoubtedly boost the usage of Cochrane Reviews and enable a global audience to access Cochrane Reviews in different formats. In December 2012 *The Cochrane Library iPad edition* was launched.

There were 20,359 views of the 'landing' page for Cochrane podcasts 'www.cochrane.org/podcasts' in 2012.

The RSS feed for Cochrane podcasts had 853 subscribers at the end of 2012, a 21% increase on the total number of subscribers at the end of 2011 (672).

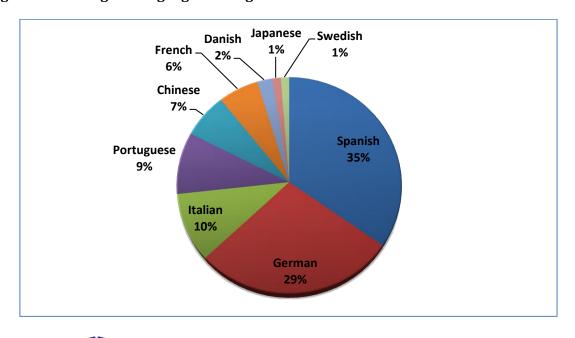

e) A select number of Cochrane reviews are now chosen each month to appear in *The Cochrane Library iPad edition*. The app was launched and made available via the Apple iTunes store on December 12th 2012. The app was downloaded and installed 3,235 times from the day of launch to the end of December. In the same period, 570 users set up a subscription in order to receive an alert via the Apple Newsstand when a new issue is published. Usage statistics for the app were only made available from January 2013 onwards.
