

Exceptions to named peer review: special cases

Consumers

As set out in the policy ([see details](#)), consumer peer reviewers are exempt from the named peer review process and may choose to remain anonymous. (Consumers still follow the policy for [Declarations of potential conflicts of interest for peer reviewers](#).)

Exceptions approved by Network Senior Editor or Editor in Chief

If a Cochrane Review Group believes that the peer review process for a particular Cochrane Review will be significantly negatively impacted by using named peer review, the Managing Editor or Co-ordinating Editor may apply to the Editor in Chief of the Cochrane Library for a policy exception on a **review-by-review basis**. In each case the Cochrane Review Group must provide details, including the reason for opting to remain anonymous.
